## **HOW DO I FIND FULLNESS WITH THE WONDERFUL COUNSELOR?**

### **1.) BE BRUTALLY HONEST.**

### **2.) LISTEN TO THE COUNSELOR'S VOICE.**

**Mark 9:2-4, 7** <sup>2</sup> After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. <sup>3</sup> His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. <sup>4</sup> And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. <sup>7</sup> Then a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and a voice came from the cloud: "***This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!***"

**John 10:27** My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

### **3.) DO WHAT THE COUNSELOR TELLS YOU TO DO.**

**Mark 10:20-21(a)** "Teacher," he declared, "all these I have kept since I was a boy." Jesus looked at him and loved him.

**Mark 10:21(b)-22** "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." At this the man's face fell. He went away sad, because he had great wealth.
