

**I. JESUS IS MIGHTY GOD.**

**Isaiah 9:6 NKJV**...<sup>6</sup> For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, **Mighty God**, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

**Gibbwr (ghib-bōre')** Strongest, Most powerful, Champion

**Jer 32:17 NIV**<sup>17</sup> “Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

**II. IF JESUS IS ALL-POWERFUL AND UNCONDITIONALLY LOVING, WHY DO I STILL SUFFER?**

**John 16:33 NIV**<sup>33</sup> “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

**I Peter 4:12-13 NLT**<sup>12</sup> Dear friends, don't be surprised at the fiery trials you are going through, as if something strange were happening to you.<sup>13</sup> Instead, be very glad—for these trials make you partners with Christ in his suffering, so that you will have the wonderful joy of seeing his glory when it is revealed to all the world.

**III. HOW DOES JESUS' POWER WORK?**

1.) His power is at work \_\_\_\_ you.

**Phil 2:13 NLT**<sup>13</sup> For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him.

**Eph 3:20 NIV**<sup>20</sup> Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.

2.) His power is at work \_\_\_\_\_ you.

**Psalms 33:16, 18-19 NIV**<sup>16</sup> No king is saved by the size of his army; no warrior escapes by his great strength.<sup>18</sup> But the eyes of the LORD are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love,<sup>19</sup> to deliver them from death and keep them alive in famine.

3.) His power is at work \_\_\_\_\_ you.

**Acts 1:8 NIV**<sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

**I Cor 2:3-5 NIV**<sup>3</sup> I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling.<sup>4</sup> My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power,<sup>5</sup> so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.

**IV. FULL \_\_\_\_\_ AND TOTAL \_\_\_\_\_ IN OUR WEAKNESS DRAW HIS POWER.**

**II Chron 16:9 NIV**<sup>9</sup> For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.

**II Cor 12:9-10 NIV**<sup>9</sup> But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.<sup>10</sup> That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
