

WORSHIP TEAM GUIDELINES

**By participating in the worship ministry, you are agreeing to the following spiritual and practical guidelines.*

Spiritual Guidelines:

1. To Know Christ as your Savior and have a consistent, growing relationship with God through: Personal time in the Word, Prayer, and Fellowship with other believers.
2. Attend The Rock at least 6 months before joining the team and complete the "Discovering the Rock" class within 6 months of joining team.
3. Supporter of the church - its leadership, and the church body (vocal support, physical support, financial support, etc.).
4. Attend the Rock worship services on a regular basis on or off team weekend.
5. Attend pre-service prayer 5 minutes before all services with team.
6. Have a focus on God, not the audience; keeping the heart and mindset of... "It is about worshipping God, not just about the music or song".

Practical Guidelines:

1. Complete audition or review process.
2. Agreement and support of family regarding the commitment to worship team i.e... Spouse, parents, etc.
3. Be affirming to other team members and resolve any team conflict consistent with Jesus teaching of Matthew 18:15.
4. Be on time and prepared for practice and services and attend all rehearsals required for your team.
5. Be spiritually and musically prepared;
 - ~ Prayed up and ready for spiritual battle
 - ~ Instrument cared for and ready to play or sing
6. Be accountable for personal, spiritual and musical growth i.e....
 - ~ Not allowing one self to be complacent
 - ~ Getting involved in a small group/Bible study
 - ~ Keeping each other accountable through regular fellowship
 - ~ Willing to pursue more musical training
 - ~ Open to constructive criticism
 - ~ Have a teachable spirit
7. Keep a mentality of "one voice" with the team.
8. Be responsible to find your own replacement when not available for your team weekend...trade weekend with opposite team member or with someone on the substitute list.
9. Love the congregation, have a heart for the people.
