



**WEEK 77 | Mission Realignment | 03/22/26-03/28/26**

**LOOK BACK: TESTIMONIES & GOALS/ACCOUNTABILITY RECAP:** *Review the Mission of the FDG's together. As you look back over last week, what steps did you take to meet your action goals from your last meeting? Also, did you love on people by praying with someone, sharing your testimony with them, or sharing God's story with them?*

**LOOK UP:** This week we want to focus on FDG Mission Realignment due to unintentional 'mission drift'. A 2022 Barna survey showed that 80% of Christians are not involved in a 'discipleship community' and that less than 50% of those attending church are familiar with the term "Great Commission". This is concerning stats for the Church! At the very end of the book of Matthew (Chapter 28) Jesus gives us a final commission called the Great Commission in which He calls us as believers and followers of Christ to "Go and make disciples". This was not directed at just pastors and leaders of churches and ministries, but was a command intended for the entire body of Christ. The Mission of FDG's at The Rock aligns with this commission and is simply **'to raise up disciple-making believers who follow Jesus by experientially teaching others to walk in His ways.'** And our Goal is **'to grow continually by being missional driven and by obedience to the Great Commission of Christ – to make disciples (discipling and being disciplined).'** Our hope is that we will continually set this command of Jesus before us, and in spite of the many 'good' excuses we can come up with, that we follow this Commission of Christ! And make sure to not only disciple in our FDG's, but also disciple in our families.

**GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1. In your FDG, have you followed the 'Look Back' and 'Look Forward' sections in order to keep accountability to what you are learning? If not, what is preventing this?
2. READ Matthew 28:18-20 & Mark 16:15-18. Evaluate your life and consider your level of obedience to these commands of Jesus? Where are you deficient? Can you identify one barrier that is keeping you from these commands?
3. Share about someone who has invited you into their life in a discipleship sort of way? How was the experience? Who could you invite to walk with you and to teach them what you have learned? How can you move forward with this soon?

**LOOK FORWARD: SET GOALS & ACCOUNTABILITY:** *Spend time together in prayer.*

*(1) What needs to change in our life to better walk in obedience to these Scriptures? Write down specific steps (goals) you will take over the next week to modify your lifestyle to align with God's word and be ready to share it next week during the 'Look Back' time.*

*(2) Who can you teach to do the same in their life?*

*(3) Is there someone you can share Jesus with or someone hurting who you can pray for?*

*(4) What is one obstacle or barrier preventing you from starting a new FDG with at least one person, while still attending your current FDG? Share and pray for this barrier to be removed.*
