



**WEEK 82 | The Ministry of the Holy Spirit | 05/03/26-05/09/26**

**LOOK BACK: TESTIMONIES & GOALS/ACCOUNTABILITY RECAP:** *As you look back over last week, what steps did you take to meet your action goals from your last meeting? Also, did you love on people by praying with someone, sharing your testimony with them, discipling them, or sharing God's story with them?*

**LOOK UP:** This week we looked at the ministry of the Holy Spirit. He is not a vague force or passing emotion, but the promised Spirit of the God of Israel, poured out through the exalted Messiah, Jesus. The Holy Spirit reveals Jesus and leads us into truth, transforms our lives to put Christlike character on display, empowers the church for witness and mission, and seals us as God's own people for the resurrection and kingdom to come. Through the Spirit, Jesus is made precious to us, sin is resisted, courage is given, and hope is strengthened as we wait for His second coming. I hope this encourages you to welcome the Holy Spirit's work daily, walk closely with Him, and live with confidence in the promises of God.

**GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1. *Read Galatians 5:22-25. Which area of your character most needs the Holy Spirit's transforming work right now, and what would it look like this week to "keep in strap with the Spirit" there?*
2. *Read 1 Cor. 2:1-5. Is there a person in your life you sense God may want you to encourage, pray for, or share Jesus with this week? What would it look like to depend on the Holy Spirit instead of your own confidence?*
3. *Read Rom. 8:11 and Eph. 1:13-14. When you feel discouraged, weary, or tempted, how could remembering the Holy Spirit as God's promise of what is coming change the way you respond this week?*

**LOOK FORWARD: SET GOALS & ACCOUNTABILITY:** *Spend time together in prayer.*

*(1) Where is the Holy Spirit calling you to grow or obey this week? Write down one specific step and be ready to share next week.*

*(2) Who can you encourage, pray for, serve, or share Jesus with this week?*

*(3) Who could you begin discipling or inviting into an FDG, and what obstacle do you need prayer for?*
